Types of WES Evaluations

Document-by-Document Evaluation (Basic or ICAP—for ICAP see below)

Identifies, describes, and provides a U.S. equivalency for each credential. Appropriate for employment, immigration, or freshman applicants to higher education institutions.

Course-by-Course Evaluation (Basic or ICAP—for ICAP see below)

Identifies, describes, and provides a U.S. equivalency for each credential. Lists all courses with their corresponding credits and grades, and includes a grade point average (GPA) calculated on a 4.0 scale. Appropriate to use for admission to higher education, professional licensing, or any other purpose requiring a detailed course analysis.

International Credential Advantage Package (ICAP)

ICAP promises that WES will store the verified academic documents which were used to evaluate an applicant's credentials and send them together with the completed evaluation report to qualified recipients.
